Mr. Albert Eugene McKinnon Sr., age 94, a resident of Lowndesboro, Alabama, passed away peacefully on Saturday, January 17, 2026. He was born on November 17, 1931, in Tampa, Florida, to the late Charles D. McKinnon and Dollie Helen Sumner McKinnon. Mr. McKinnon proudly served his country in the United States Army and Air Force for 20 years before retiring in 1968. In 1967 he was ordained as a Baptist minister and was a bi-vocational pastor of several churches for many years. Following his military service, he began a career in law enforcement, serving with several departments before retiring in 2019, at the age of 88, from Troy State University, Montgomery.
