David Evans Wilson - a faithful servant of Jehovah, devoted husband and father, and loving shepherd of God's flock – finished his life April 23, 2017. He was 57 years old.

David's goal was to imitate Jesus by sprinting toward the end of his race, and he accomplished that. His life was full, lacking nothing, because of his deep love and devotion to his Heavenly Father, the "God of all comfort" who we trust will remember his loyal servant fondly in the future resurrection.

Raised in Selma by his parents, Robert and Vonceil, David often spoke fondly of accompanying his father and mother in the ministry. When he was a boy, he was trained "in the way he should go." As he grew older, he did "not depart from it." He was baptized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses on October 15, 1972. Serving God and helping others learn the Bible's truth had since remained the focal point of his life.

He served as an elder in the congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses for decades and expanded his ministry in 2009 by learning American Sign Language. Known as "DW" by his sign language family, he volunteered alongside his wife and daughter, Rhonda and Desiree, in a congregation that helped deaf and hard-of-hearing people in the Montgomery area.

David, imitating the Bible figure with whom he shares a name, never let trials or setbacks prevent him from displaying a positive attitude and doing all he could to honor Jehovah and help other people.

He was preceded in death by his father, Robert S. Wilson. He is survived by his wife, Rhonda; his daughter, Desiree; mother, Vonceil; as well as an extended spiritual family of brothers and sisters who look forward to seeing him awaken when Jesus releases the righteous from their graves.

A service will be held on Saturday, May 6 at 1 p.m. at the Westport Kingdom Hall of Jehovah's Witnesses, 112 Greenleaf Drive, Montgomery, AL. Brother Jon Ledbetter will deliver the memorial discourse.
