“*Doyle has been a dear friend to me for more than forty years. We met as co-workers at Gunter Air Force Base upon his assignment there some time after I arrived at Gunter in 1971. He immediately became a friend - the kind of friend you just liked to be around. Doyle was always willing to help anyone who needed him, and as a skilled craftsman, he was able to find a way to do almost anything you wanted help with, and he did it well. As a member of the US Air Force Doyle proudly served his country well, patriotic to the depths of his being. In his military service and in his capacity as a civil servant and a contractor, he gained and well deserved the respect and admiration of his fellow workers, upper management and those of other organizations with whom his work brought him in contact. You could depend on Doyle. His advice was sound, his decisions reliable and his work without error. Doyle gave it his best and he did it right. Stamped permanently on my memory was the time I met him in the corridor of the hospital in Birmingham. His son, Bobby, has been in a near-fatal car wreck and had been taken there because he needed special care. It was not at all certain Bobby would survive. As soon as I heard, I think the same day or the day after the accident, I headed to Birmingham to be with the family. As I walked toward the room I saw Doyle walking in my direction with his head down. When he looked up and saw me we grabbed onto each other and for a long while no words were spoken. We just stood there hugging each other and sobbing. Doyle was a family man. He loved Sandy and his children devotedly and would not have hesitated to give his life for any one of them. I loved Doyle and I'm convinced he loved me, and as friends we often said that to each other. I miss him, and I grieve that in this life we shall not meet again. It is my hope that, as children of God and as brothers in Jesus Christ, we shall meet again one day. May the God of all blessing and strength give comfort to the Arnold family and to Doyle's friends in this time of our great loss.*”
