Edward "Eddie" A. Hancuff, Jr., 59, of Prattville, Alabama, passed away unexpectedly on August 15, 2025. His sudden departure leaves a deep void in the lives of his family and friends who loved him dearly.

Born on September 12, 1965, in Meadville, Pennsylvania, Eddie lived a full life marked by love, hard work, and devotion to his family. He was a true rock—steady, dependable, and deeply caring. Eddie had a gift for making those around him feel supported, and his presence brought comfort and joy to all who knew him.

He began his adult life working alongside his father before attending college and later spent a year in Ghana doing missionary work. Eddie went on to serve in the U.S. Air Force where he discovered his calling in a career working with his hands. As a dedicated Structural Technician, he proudly gave 20 years of service, traveling wherever he was asked and often volunteering. His skill, work ethic, and steady presence earned him the respect of colleagues and lifelong friendships.
