Harold Stephen Malone went home to his Lord and Savior on April 18, 2024, after suffering from complications of Parkinson's Disease. He was in his home and surrounded by his loving family.

The oldest son of Hugh and Mary Lou Malone, Harold was born on February 8, 1940, outside of Atmore, Alabama in the small community of Poarch, Alabama, where he was a member of Judson Baptist Church. He graduated from Escambia County High School in 1958, where he was chosen as the 1958 Good Citizen winner for excelling in dependability, service, leadership and patriotism. He carried these qualities throughout his life and instilled them into his children and grandchildren.

Harold married his first wife in Atmore, and they had two children, Blake Malone and Kelly Malone (Walker). During this time, Harold began working for BellSouth. While his first marriage did not last, he met the love of his life, Wanda Kanaday, in 1983. They married in 1984 and had three children, David, Amanda, and Jonathan.
