Thomas, Henrietta. (nee Harris) died quietly in her home in Millbrook, AL on Monday, March 9, 2015 after a 3 year battle with pancreatic cancer. Henrietta was born October 26, 1945 in Asheville, NC, to the late Rev. Robert L. Harris and Clara L. Harris. She was educated in the Philadelphia School system and was a 1963 graduate of Germantown High School. Henrietta received a Bachelors Degree in Social Work from Bennett College in Greensboro, NC. In September 1968, Henrietta was united in matrimony to Lee A, Thomas, Sr. To this union two children were born, Lee A. Thomas, Jr.who preceded his mother in death and Andrietta Thomas of Dover, Delaware. For many years Henrietta worked for the Social Security Administration as SSI Specialist. After taking an early retirement from SSA she continued her career working for the Reliance and Unum Insurance Companies. Henrietta was an active member of the United Methodist Church where she served on various ministries and boards until the time of her death. She was also an active Lifetime member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority. After relocating to Millbrook, Alabama in 2010, Henrietta continued in her lifetime passion for serving others as she accepted the position as the Director of W.E.L.C.O.M.E. She also united with the Millbrook 1st United Methodist Church and continued to take an active role in the ministry of church. Henrietta's love to help others was ultimately displayed in her death when she offered the gift of herself by dedicating her body to science to aid in pancreatic cancer research. In addition to her husband and her daughter she is survived by her mother, 4 brothers, 2 sisters and a host of
