James Edward Crosby passed away Tuesday, January 16, 2018 at the age of 72. James, son of the late Zeke Crosby Jr. and Sallie Thomas Crosby was born December 1, 1945 in Elmore, Alabama. He grew up on the family farm with his Mother, Father, Grandmother Mary Crosby and his siblings. James was the 11th of 16 children and graduated from Sandtown High School.

In 1964, James joined the United States Army and was stationed at Fort Bragg, NC, where he served as a paratrooper in the 82nd Airborne Division. Upon completion of his enlistment, James attended Trenholm Technical College, studying auto-body and fender repair. James was employed with Old L&N Railroad, now known as CSX, as a conductor until he retired after 30 years.
