Mr. Mac Arthur Glenn age 75, a resident of Huntsville, AL passed away on Sunday, April 26, 2020. Graveside services will be held on Wednesday, May 6, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. at Long Cemetery with Pastor James Jackson officiating. Mac was born March 20, 1945 to Alfred & Caroline Glenn in Millbrook, AL. He was a graduate of Sandtown High School and would later earn his bachelors degree in criminal justice from the University of Southern California. He served in the US Marine Corps during the Vietnam era and went on to work for Boeing while finishing his degree. Mac returned to Alabama and worked briefly as a state highway patrolman posted in Selma, AL. Mac returned to military service in 1970 with the Alabama Air National Guard and later transferring to the Air Force Reserves retiring as a Master Sergeant in 2005. While actively serving in the Air Force Reserves, Mac also was a corrections officer and through his hard work, he was promoted to parole officer where he also retired from in later years. He is survived by his wife Maxine Glenn; children Jeremy Glenn (Natasha) and Toneka Pate; his grandsons Machai & Elijah; brother Earl Glenn (Anna) and sisters Wanda Perry (Walter) & Marsilla Feagin; nieces & nephews - Maya Perry, Sherry Parker, Gretchen Glenn, London Perry, Daniel Glenn & Tony Glenn as well as many great nieces, great nephews, extended family & friends.
