Buster, Maury Allen passed away on Tuesday November 22, 2016 in Montgomery, AL at the age of 52. Maury was born September 19, 1964 to Don & Carla (Jones) Buster in Corpus Christi, TX. A 1983 graduate of W.B. Ray High School in Corpus Christi, Maury would go on to earn his bachelor's degree from Southern Nazarene University in Bethany OK, master's degree from the University of Tulsa, Tulsa, OK and ultimately his PhD in Quantitative Methods from the University of Oklahoma, Norman, OK. As he was completing his path to a PhD, Maury was a psychologist for the State of Oklahoma, as well as serving as a youth minister at Western Oaks & a detention counselor for the troubled teens. Maury then relocated to San Antonio, TX where he worked for USAA. From there, he was actively recruited to work for the State of Alabama as the Chief Industrial Organization Psychologist and it was there where he served in the capacity of handling discrimination lawsuits as well as improving the application & promotional testing for prospective & current state employees. His work was instrumental in resolving a decades long class action lawsuit against the state. He was very dedicated to his work for the State of Alabama Personnel Department working up until he passed away. He never let any illness or setback keep him from getting his work done. Above all of his many achievements and accolades, Maury was a humble soul who deeply loved the Lord and his family - he would never complain about his many challenges, but always put care & concern for others above his needs. His children & grandchildren were his pride & joy and

he will be sorely missed by all those who loved him. Maury was survived by his loving wife of 29 yrs, Dana (Bumpus) Buster. His love & admiration for her was steadfast as she cared for him throughout his health challenges.
