Robert Edward Fenn, age 87, a resident of Wetumpka, AL, passed away on Saturday September 09, 2017. Robert was born in Montgomery, Alabama to William Frank & Neva Mae (Wallraven) Fenn. Robert was also a US Navy veteran & graduate of Auburn University where he was recognized as the 1st walk on starting player in Auburn University Basketball history. He spent over 30 years working as an educator in Elmore County. His innovative approaches to education have left a lasting imprint in Elmore County; he brought physical education to the curriculum as well as establishing the Pre-First program that assisted children with the transition from Kindergarten to First Grade. He would retire as the school principal at Robinson Springs Elementary School. Robert is survived by his loving family; sons Bobby (Dianne) Fenn of Alma, GA, Mike (Sheila) Fenn of Birmingham, AL, John (Phyllis) Fenn of Wetumpka, AL, & Mark (Leigh Ann) Fenn of Fuquay - Varina, NC; 11 grandchildren & 7 great grandchildren.
