His passion for Equality between Gay, Straight and Transgender people prompted him to open Hojon's, a popular Dance and Entertainment Club in Downtown Montgomery on Court St. Ted was interviewed in the Daily Beast about his involvement with the City of Montgomery and Gay Rights. Ted is a former graduate of Auburn University. He was on the Swim Team and placed in the SEC. Ted's passion for Creating 4 Star foods prompted him to open The Olive Room & Nobles on Montgomery St. in downtown Montgomery. Ted later went on to become the Chef at Mr. G's.

Ted's fight with Cancer has been a long one. He beat the cancer, but the radiation got the better of him. Ted has a big heart and during his time at Nobles & Olive room, he would feed the attendees of Celebrate Recovery at Cloverdale Baptist Church on his own dime. He also cooked for the Wine Vintner's Dinner yearly at Mark and Gage Lequire's Home. In the past he helped with HUGS, an organization helping the Homeless in Montgomery and surrounding counties. He volunteered for many years at the Family Sunshine Center and was Volunteer of the Year in 2009. He was also known for his laugh. He could be in a crowd of 500 and you could spot him by his laugh. Ted cared for and gave his all to anyone that needed his help. Ted was preceded in death by his mother & father, Margaret Lee and Thad M. Nobles Sr. Ted is

survived by his Spouse & Life partner of 40 years, Stephen McGraw-Nobles of Montgomery, two Brothers, Edgar (Tampa, Fla) and Martin (Chattanooga, Tn.) Nobles. Three Nieces, Ashley, Callie, and Amanda Nobles. Two Nephews, David and Matthew Nobles. A Grand Nephew, Donovan Nobles, an aunt, Jane Moore (Greenville, NC), A host of Cousins and Great Friends & His Cloverdale Baptist Church Family.
