While stationed in Alaska for the second time, MSgt Froden served as the NCOIC of Data Automation, and his beloved wife, Evelyn, managed the Tundra Tavern and the ski lodge on Eielson AFB. While in service, MSgt Froden received the following awards: Bronze Star and Vietman Gallantry Cross. In retirement William moved to Montgomery, AL and served in the civil service at Maxwell and Gunter AFB's for 16 years. William Froden was passionate about assisting the elderly in his Montgomery Community. William volunteered his time and service for Meals on Wheels for 5 years and Hospice of Montgomery for 2 years.
